JPIC is part of our life and mission. It is a prophetic compromise proposed by C apítulos G erais of the Company, Congregação and the International ICDS Assembly to perform and raise awareness of the **Justice**, **Peace and Integrity of Creation**, is part of our mission to serve to the interpellations of the Gospel of Jesus the Savior, in defense of human dignity, which recreates fraternity, promoting more respect for all divine creation.

Promoting good living we are in line with the guidelines, the Declaration of the Salvatorian Family and guidelines of Pope Francis to be an outgoing Church.

In the various places of presence of members of the Salvatorian family, many activities apostolic in defense of life, the pursuit of peace and to promote self-sustainability as practice result in dignity and justice, that recreate the fraternity and a healthy environment for the integrity of creation and the balance of nature.

1. COMMITMENT TO PEACE

Our commitment to justice, peace and the integrity of creation leads us to take actions to raise awareness and promote a culture of peace and solidarity and a dignified life.

Salvatorian College Immaculate Conception PEACE WEEK: Peace how is it done?

On September 17 the CSIC school community found an environment prepared for reflection and awareness of the importance of living peace in all places of our coexistence. The week of September 17 to 21, peace week, students were surprised every day with activities that strengthened and motivated a life of peace, with the goal of identifying the aspects to be improved and worked within the school and family environment. The opening began with a circle of conversation mediated by the teacher and a monitor of the CTP, with a scenario that led to reflection, through the dynamics "The boy named Love", addressing issues such as: dialogue, solidarity, coexistence, small gestures, improvement the environment. From this reflection they pointed out improvement proposals to be assumed as a group. There were prayers and the universal prayer of our Father. The following phrase was marked as a message of this day: "PEACE is not what we find in a place without noise, without problems, without hard work, but what allows us to remain calm in our heart, even in the midst of the most adverse situations. "Following the week of peace, students and educators were daily working on peace-related activities organized by the Pastoral Coordinator, differentiated according to age and shift. In the morning, reflections were made with sharing, emphasizing the importance of small daily gestures of solidarity, ecumenical celebration with delivery of the tape with the motto "Peace is the fruit of love", integration sports, the secret of the chest and the fraternization with sharing of snacks. In the afternoon shift, with the theme: Peace, how do you do it? with activities carried out by the teacher of the class with exhibition of the works, two hours of training with each class, with conversation wheel, video, chat, how to be better at school and family, fraternal attitudes, music and interaction with others. They made cards with thoughts of peace and received a magnet to fix in the refrigerator of their house. On the last day a celebration of Ecumenical Life with the blessing and distribution of the buns. We believe in peace in this world that so longs and needs. The "Peace Week" project was based on the values of Christianity, which are based on a fraternal and solidary human life.

COMMUNITY Horizon

Completed in 2018. Project Transformation in Art.

In the initial planning for the year 2018, the project was designed together with the work team (coordinator, technical staff and monitors) to develop activities related to the theme: "Our choices", and a "path" with words was produced with the beneficiaries incentive, motivation and the search for better alternatives of life. This action was of great value, since both the adolescents and their caregivers could be aware that the life history can have different paths and not repetition of family context, this can be concluded by the reports of them during the execution of the activity. Thus, motivating individuals to dialogue about their conditions and motivate them to seek better living conditions is to form conscious citizens capable of transforming their social reality.





November/29 - IMED School Auditorium

Participation of children and adolescents at the Municipal Conference on the Rights of Children and Adolescents, with the theme: Integral protection, diversity and confrontation of violence. This event provided our teens with active participants, giving suggestions and opinions about the importance of having entities that serve the public in the area of children and adolescents. What this means in the life of each of them, because, being in the street are at the mercy of situations of all kinds of violations of rights, since the great majority reside in extremely violent and vulnerable neighborhoods. In short, they are spaces for debates, smiles, reflection and connection that make the Conference an odd event on the agenda of human rights in the area of children and adolescents. This is transformation.

This seminar was attended by Provincials, animators (s) of Nuclei, interested in the cause of justice, think tanks, orders and Institutes of the Regional, SP.

Annually sponsored by JPIC / SP and REDE A GRITO PELA VIDA, and the support of the Board of Directors of CRB Regional SP and other groups, this seminar takes place that seeks to raise awareness, inform and encourage everyone who in their daily practice is focused on actions the construction of the Kingdom.

The theme: Analysis of political and social conjuncture from the Prophetic of Religious Life, guided this event, fulfilling the needs and priorities of this year of elections.

Advising of Sr. Maria Freire - Prophetic of Religious Life: Based on the Biblical texts like the prophets who have the mission of announcing and denouncing mainly Social inequality. Prophetic Religious Life: Unprecedented gift, passion.

The VC rescues the OT prophecy, where the prophets do not create a new spirituality. They drink from the great paradigmatic experience of all the biblical people and actualize it. They denounce everything that contradicts the mystique that gave identity and was concretized in the covenant of God with his people. It is a spirituality of communion and unity, of solidarity, related to the transformation of society

The Hebrew term in question was captured by the Greek term prophetes, which means "to speak for", "to represent", or "someone who speaks in the place of another" (Ex 4: 16,16). According to the etymology of "nabhi," "the function of a prophet is to act as divine ambassador or messenger, announcing the will of God for his people, especially at that time of crisis ".

He then emphasizes the care of creation

Take care of the common house and promote the integral ecology, which is rooted and nourished by a deep ecological spirituality. The common good presupposes respect for the human person, demands social welfare, development of the various intermediary groups, subsidiarity, family, social peace, and distributive justice (LS 157).

In the world everything is connected, hence the intimate relationship between the poor and the fragility of the Planet (LS 16). We need an ecological conversion, which implies letting all the consequences of our encounter with Jesus Christ in our relations with the world around us (LS 217).

The prophetic consecrated life is able to rejoice in hearing the cry of the desperate / poor scroungers of the globalized world, in touching the wounds gestated in the violent dawns of life, in seeing the faces torn by the growing fear of tomorrow.

Sr. Maria Freire concluded with these final words:

"To project a Consecrated Life in openness to the world, in constant contact with the poor, the wounded, and the lepers of the peripheries. Descending, approaching, gutting, embracing the unprotected and caring for him, and engaging others in care. It is to open the gates of the heart and eviscerate in the solidarity meeting. It is to design new relational forms for the communities, and, under the ideal vestment, to weave a real body molded by prophetic-missionary action in the redemption of the face of the poor.

2nd Topic - Human Trafficking in the Current Socioeconomic Situation Politics and How to refer Human Trafficking cases - Dra. Sílvia - Lawyer of Curitiba and volunteer / network partner.

We also decided to deepen a 3rd Theme: Ways of Welcoming and listening to the victims and their families, theme worked by the Psychologist Sr. Marina of the Dominican Sisters of the Anunciata resident in Belo Horizonte. It was a meeting that provoked and challenged us to continue in the Prevention of Trafficking in Persons.

We feel the great challenges in our Country and in the Brazilian Borders with the great number of Migrants who cross our borders every day, since these are the biggest victims of this evil that plagues the world and we commit ourselves to prevent the traffic in all the spaces in that we operate.

Dr. Cláudia Luna lawyer and expert on the issue of violence against women and human trafficking. She has been in the area for 30 years, a great partner and collaborator of Grito Um Grito Pela Vida Network, not only in São Paulo but also in different realities throughout the country. She made her statement on the legal system of guaranteeing the rights of women, Art. 15 CF / 88. However, as Brazilian society is based on two important characteristics: MACHINERY AND RACISM, women are hardly benefited by the aforementioned laws, which theoretically are almost perfect, but very little well applied. He talked about the Maria da Penha Law. He also said that violence against women implies a fall in the GDP of populations and nations where they are practiced with greater vehemence. The issue of TP is still not recognized as a cause of fall in the country's GDP. The TP generates "profit" for the country. The populations affected by PD are the so-called "social wastes". For the legislators it matters little

the question of the TP, because those who are having the subtracted life are people that in thesis, only give expenses. Structures of violence are rooted in the foundation of our society, which makes it almost impossible to eliminate them. SYNDROME OF BEHAVIOR BEHAVIOR that passes from generation to generation. According to the delegate, the only way to end this vicious circle is for the EDUCATION of the new generations of women and men to live a relationship of respect and dignity.

In the end it presents several possible practices that can make a difference in our society.

We also have Dr. Silvia Xavier de Curitiba, PR representative of the nucleus of confrontation to the Trafficking of People of the State of Paraná. With concern and sadness informed us that the state of Paraná is among the worst in the issue of trafficking in persons, since it is close to the borders of Paraguay and other countries facilitating the leakage ... He told us several cases and concrete situations that happen at all times that requires a lot of attention and agility. A great collaborator, partner and admirer of the "A Grito por la Vida" network, she left her contact and made herself available to the group: phone: 041 998430434 (Dr. Silvia Xavier).

It is worth deepening all the wealth shared in this meeting with other groups forming leaders willing to fight for life.

We also had the valuable participation of Sr. Marina (Dominican) with the theme: Welcoming and listening to the victims of trafficking and their families.

Exercises of personal integration, of perception of ourselves and of space - inner pacification: very important to enable us to listen attentively to self and others.

Unveiled the theme "Listening that welcomes and integrates the person". He guided us how to deal with trafficked people.

We also had moments of sharing experiences and materials from different nuclei, moments of fellowship. Diverse mystical moments guided by Regions.

The regional ones passed their perspectives for the year 2019.

It was moments of great wealth and now let's get down to business!

WE PARTICIPATE AS A NETWORK A SCREAM FOR LIFE IR. CIRLEY, GO. FILOMENA TOMINAGA AND IR. GIANE.

International Coalition Against Trafficking in Women in Latin America and the Caribbean and the Presence of Latin America - PAL. (Presence of Latin America is a civil society organization created in 2004 with the purpose of articulating and strengthening Latin American communities residing in Brazil). The meeting was free to assess ways to combat crime that makes two million victims a year in the world. It is the trafficking of people, in the XXI century! People selling and buying people as if they were objects, merchandise. Crime that has as main victims girls and women for sexual exploitation. Inhuman and cruel, trafficking in persons also makes victims for slave labor, for illegal adoption, and for taking organs for transplants.

Participants included experts from Argentina, Mexico, Norway, the United States and Brazil

Doren Leitholdt USA, executive member of CAT. Director Santuary for Families, NY: USA - Also defends the end of prostitution and against legalization of it as

work. According to Doren the commercialization of human bodies can never be considered legalized profession.

Dr. Fábio Bechara - Promoter of Justice of SP. Executive Secretary of the Public Prosecutor's Office of SP and a founding member of NETP (Nucleus for coping with Trafficking in Persons) Dr. Fábio made an outstanding placement since Brazil signed the Palermo Protocol in 2000, which was only filed in 2003. It is sad that unfortunately after 15 years ... is a long way from being taken seriously by society. "Brazil has made great progress in the construction of laws and programs against different social crimes, corruption, terrorism and others ... But the big challenge lies in the application of this and other laws through Public Policies that actually benefit people who need support and protection. "We are very good at taking pictures but very bad at building films." In Dr's vision "What we lack is greater corporativity and less individualism of public organizations and bodies." No one wants to share the power of decision and He is harmed by all that is the needy victims. Our problem is to put together all the issues in connection and not separately. (Health - Social Asset - Law - Civil Society Police - Coping nuclei ... throw everything in a basket and look for the common data ... we would see that the object of the action is the same ... and left us a question: E Why do not you move on? How can we get out of this crisis?

Priscila Dalledone Siqqueira - National and international articulator in the fight against trafficking, director and adviser of several NGOs. She points out that as long as it does not change the conception of woman that is in the head of the majority of the country's sexist population and of the world little or nothing advances beautiful speeches and hundreds of agreements and seminars ... "we are all playing the fools ..." finally there were many valuable comments that can be found on the site www.palbrasil.com.br.

He began by presenting the two proposals of the Year of the Laity: 1) The Layman, subject in the Church and in the world. 2a). Subject = salt and light in the world to salt, conserve, lighten and lighten. Presenting the analysis of conjuncture, or Analysis of Reality requested the participation of the assembly to express what would be the tripod on which is based the Church in his, or better in our performance: WORD OF GOD - SACRAMENTS - CHARITY. In summary, the formation made us reflect on awakening the commitment of baptized persons for greater conviction and involvement. ->. Hear the cries of the needy. -> Give more attention to youth. ->. Formation for Lay Spiritual Assistants - Theme: Faith and Politics.

The same theme dealt with in the formation of the laity of the Southern Region was also applied in the Southeast Region by the team formed by JPIC, where the Salvationan's Lay Dolaine Coimbra assumed and conducted the same formation as an advisor.

This training theme was very important because of the socio - cultural - economic momentum of the Brazilian population, and the spiritual assistant and retreat advisors, to whom this training was intended, represent leaderships that should encourage lay people to be protagonists of the their time promoting decent living conditions and living well for the people where it is needed.









3.THE ENVIRONMENT: THE GREATNESS OF DIVINE CREATION

COMMUNITY Horizon

Community where inserted the Project Transformation in Art.

In our community we have workers in the area of recycling, as well as iron "binders". Thus, we work together, enabling a space that encourages recyclers their importance in the process of environmental preservation. With regard to the "amarradores" of iron, the need arose for them to work homeless from the sun and rains, with the help of benefactors of the project Transformation in Art, it was possible to provide them with brasilit to erect a cover to shelter and work down. We realized that this attitude toward the workers allowed better conditions for them to develop and learn continuously with their own work, encouraging more individuals to assist in this activity. It is important to note that these workers are excluded from the world of formal work, low schooling, lack of information and lack of social minimums. Actions that aim at the common good, inventive the culture of a more just and humane society.







Patronato Santo Antonio de São José dos Pinhais-PR.

Theoretical and practical course of entomology with Ildebrando Nora for sisters and employees of the Patronato Santo Antonio de São José dos Pinhais-PR.

On April 23rd and 24th the Santo Antônio Patronato, in partnership with the company EPAGRI (Agricultural Research and Rural Extension Company of Santa Catarina), carried out a very important training of its work team, which works in agriculture. The entomology course focused on the development of biotechnology. The same counted on theoretical classes and simultaneously the practice. This had as its axis the identification of pests and their natural enemies, associated with vegetables and fruit trees. The bioecological aspects of the main pests associated with vegetables were deepened.









Training, preparation and application of bio-ecological products

The training was complemented with training on the preparation and application of bio-ecological products in different situations such as: plants, sewage systems, in the preparation of organic fertilizers using various types of materials. In the practices the institution was based on the reflection of the Encyclical Laudato Si, of Pope Francisco, where we draw attention to care with the Planet our Common House.







During the year 2018. Use of oil and ecological soap production by general service employees.

Aimed at caring for the environment, awareness activities were developed in our daily lives, one of them being questions about what we play in our rivers. From this action appeared the practical activity of exploitation of the oil of discard, used in the manufacture of soap. In this activity, officials responsible for general services were involved. Besides the use to meet their own demands, their surplus is marketed generating sustainability resources.

2. SOLIDARY CHRISTMANS

In this campaign, the families of children and elementary school students of the Salvatoriano Immaculada Conceição College were asked to contribute donations of children's clothing and shoes and school bags in good condition to donate to the needy families registered in Cáritas of Videira. The Christmas of all those who contributed with this gesture of solidarity, were present in the lives of these families in need.

Visit of Solidarity in the building that collapsed in São Paulo in Largo do Paissandu.

On May 1, 2018.

It was an ex-building of the Federal Police, inhabited in bad conditions by the invaders. The fire was caused by the explosion of gas cylinder.

The visit took place on May 23, 2018 because the homeless people were living in the tents armed in front of the Church as we see in the photo below. Several families were living there with donations from people passing by. Kitchens were improvised in canvas and plastic stalls. The toilets of São Paulo prefecture have put some in the place. Several families and children were awaiting referral.

The JPIC and "A cry for life group network" was present several times until they were all sent. Being present I support women and children sometimes with help with food and talking to the children as they were being threatened to separate the children from the mothers.

It was more than 3 months until they got a place to stay.

INAUGURATION OF THE BUILDING OPERATING THE PROJECT "NEW LIFE"

Sr. Filomena was present at the inauguration Mass of the building where the PROJECT "VIDA NOVA" works, after the restructuration of it. In the "Year of Mercy", the Archdiocese of São Paulo chose as the Marco de Misericórdia the restraint and adequacy of the 10 floors of the Nazaré Building in Praça da Sé (loaned by the third order of Carmo) and entrusted the work to the Mission Belém.

The "Vida Nova" Project offers a welcome to the street population of Praça da Sé and the Center of São Paulo in a private and familiar way.

Each floor of the building will be entrusted to a person who was rescued from the street by the welcome in the Bethlehem Mission and decided to remain on the mission.

This "father of the family", along with three other people who have a similar experience, welcomes in his apartment, for 3-6 days, the street brothers who want a new life. Those who adhere to leave this situation are sent to Bethlehem mission for "restoration" in 6 months.

In this building there are 5 floors for direct reception of the street, 3 floors are dedicated to offices, bathrooms, lecture halls, available to attend to the street population, even if it does not remain in the building. On our two floors there will be services for the benefit of those who are welcomed as a library, occupational therapy, gym and spaces for volunteers who do "street mission".

Taking knowledge of this project I share with the people who want to be part of this Project as volunteers to dodge these lives.



I represent the Solidarity Project Holding Hands to Serve, a concrete Voluntary action against misery and social inclusion within our city Várzea Paulista.

Read Carefully how it all began:

In 1997, with the desire to share a happier day with the needy families, the non-profit volunteer group came up with the "Solidarity Christmas Without Hunger" Project, where in that year we served 16 needy families, including 52 children. creator of the project my mother Dona Inez, who likes to remember that the project is only maintained thanks to all volunteers and partners.

Since then the project has expanded and in December 2018 84 complete baskets containing chicken, soda, milk, crackers, chocolate, panettone were delivered. And the joy of the children was complete with the delivery of 172 gifts, pogo games, ball pool, trampoline, breakfast meal, snacks, popcorn, cotton candy, ice cream, cake and soda.

We know that these families do not eat only in December, during the year we assist with needs such as: medicines, school supplies, food, among others, including seeking to insert in the field of work.

Returning to the initial subject, I come to inform you that about four years ago the couple Antônio and Sandra presented our work to the Salvatorian groups, since then we have the joy of being able to count on this precious help from members of the Salvatorian Laity present in our city of Várzea Paulista. - SP, where they help meeting donation requests for the realization of projects.
